Detroit River Hawk Watch Accessibility:

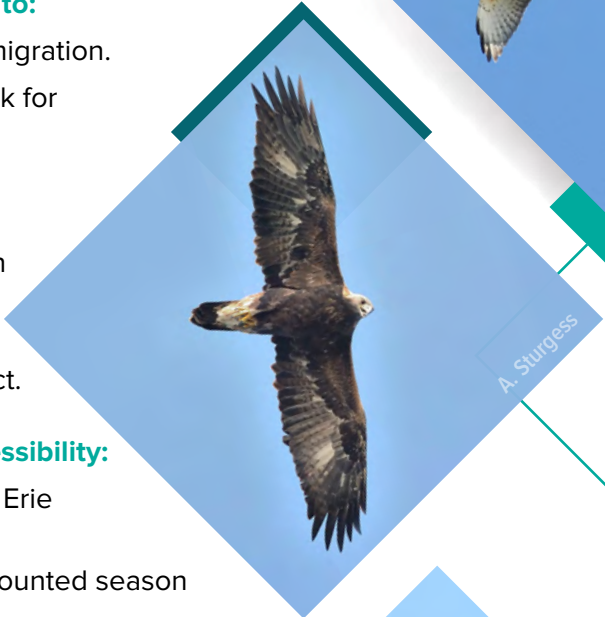
- Watch from open area at Lake Erie Metropark Boat Launch.
- \$10 daily fee for vehicles. Discounted season and senior passes available.
- Free parking with admission fee. Bring binoculars.
- Limited seating. Bring benches or lawn chairs.

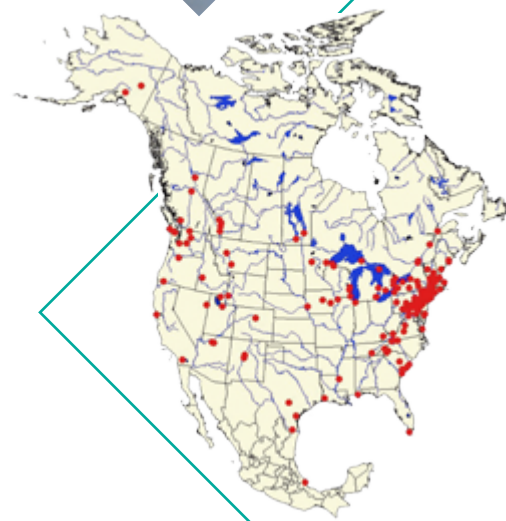
