### Greenlaw Mountain Accessibility:

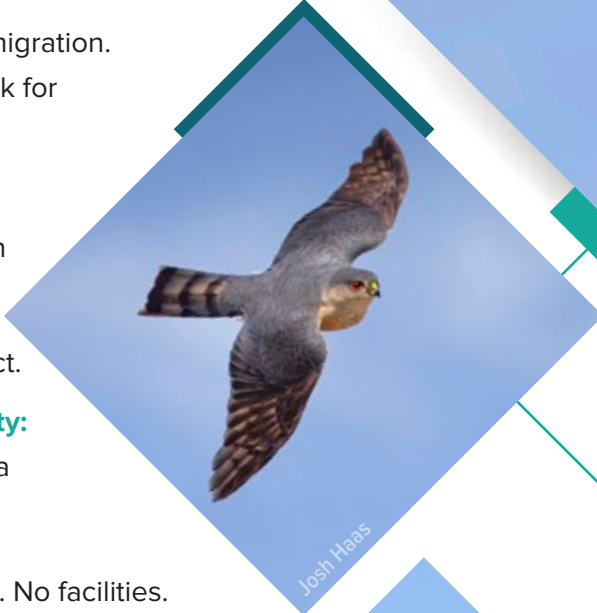
- Private property walk-in site via gravel road (2 km, uphill).
- Free parking on side of road.
- Open summit w small platform. No facilities. Food, lodging nearby in St. Andrews.

### Quick Info:

- Season Aug. 24 – Nov. 15. Daily except when winds from south.
- Only regularly staffed hawk watch in Atlantic Canada.
- Broad-winged & Sharp-shinned Hawks most abundant raptors; peak mid-Sept to mid-Oct.
- Variety of migrating songbirds, including crossbills and grosbeaks.

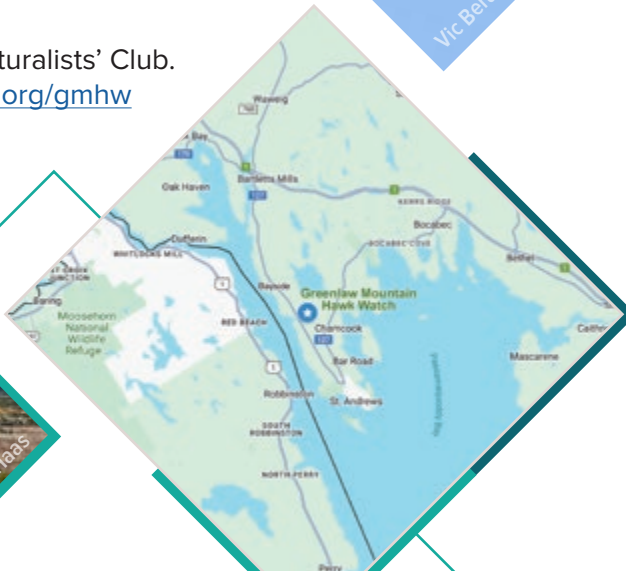

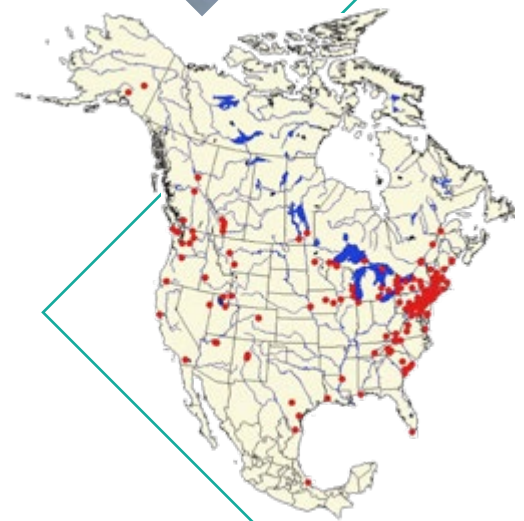
